ANNUAL REPORT (2019-20)

New Era Public School Dwarka is known for its commitment towards providing a progressive and universal education to its students through advanced and avant-garde curriculum and programs. Under the aegis of New Era Education Society, the school has received constant support and guidance from the Chairperson, Mrs. Usha Chopra, and the Director, Mr. Rohit Chopra.

The academic year 2019-20 witnessed a confluence of inventive practices into the curriculum. WoW Lite programme for students of LKG to III was continued this year as well. Along with increasing students' appetite for reading, the programme aided in nurturing students' writing and speaking abilities, along with enhancing their imagination. With the program being there for the second consecutive year, both parents and students participated in it, with a greater understanding. Students were eager to attend their WoW classes and looked forward to receiving a task on their parents' mobile phones every week.

The DEAR period, which was introduced in the previous year to acquaint students with the world of books was taken up this year too. Students were suggested two books, one for each session. After reading the book(s), each class gave a presentation describing and depicting their learning from it.

Keeping the need for developing the oratory skills of students in view, the Inter-House competitions were held throughout the year to give students a platform to express themselves with aplomb. Events such as presentations, dramatization, declamation, poetry recitation, etc. helped both the participants and the audience to grasp the language better.

Three major sports events, viz. 1st R.L. Chopra U-12 Boys Football Tournament, All India Championship Series U-14 Tennis Tournament and the Annual Sports Day (I-V), were also organized to further give impetus to students' skills in the field of sports.

It was ensured that our students take part in all events organized by New Era Public School, Mayapuri and in the co-curricular and sports events hosted by the schools in the vicinity.

It was a pleasure watching the students learn and shine through the events they participated in throughout the year.

March 2019

Orientation Programme: An Orientation programme was conducted for parents of class LKG and the new admissions on 30th March, to introduce the major programmes as well as the faculty to the parents. The facilitators from WOW and Xseed oriented the parents about their respective programmes.

April 2019

Founder's Day:

The echo of celebration reverberated in the hearts of all New Erians as they celebrated their alma mater's 60th Founder's Day on 11th and 12th April 2019 with utmost excitement and cheer. From reciting poetry to depicting their school's growth over the years through a dance drama, the students showcased their joy upon their school achieving this milestone. The event began with the students and teachers seeking blessings of the Almighty through a hawan. The song 'Showers of Blessings' was sung by the school choir along with a self-composed celebration song, dance drama and self composed poems by the students.

Earth Day:

The students of Class V organised a special assembly to commemorate Earth Day on 24th April, 2019 to propel fellow students to feel a greater sense of urgency about protecting our planet.

The importance of following the four principles of reuse, recycle, reduce and recover were stressed upon through an act by the students to keep the planet beautiful. The skit illustrated how the needs of human beings have increased and how they are mercilessly depleting the Earth's resources. It concluded with the message that we must realize the danger and start taking steps to save ourselves and our beautiful planet. We must keep it green, just like it has always been.

William Shakespeare's 455th birthday: A special assembly was organised on 25th April, 2019 for celebrating the Bard of Avon's, i.e., William Shakespeare's 455th birthday. The students learnt about the playwright and his extant works. Also, students of Grade XI presented a scene from his famous play 'Julius Caesar'.

Inter-house Competitions - Hindi Poetry Recitation and Debate: An inter house Hindi Poetry Recitation was held for classes I to V on 29th April, 2019. For classes VI to VIII and IX to XII, Story Writing Competition and Debate were held on 30th April, 2019.

Visit to the temple/gurdwara: Sensitizing students about the diverse faiths practiced around us, LKG and UKG visited the ISKON temple and the Gurdwara Singh Sabha on 25th April, 2019.

Labour Day: New Era Public School Dwarka, celebrated Labour Day to acknowledge the efforts of Class IV employees. The students of Class IV celebrated the Labour Day with a special assembly to express gratitude to the class IV employees working in the school. The employees were presented with a rose flower and chocolates as a mark of respect. Visit to the Church: Taking forth the students’ knowledge on different religions, classes LKG & UKG visited St. Thomas Church, in Janakpuri on 8th May.

On 14th May 2019, three inter- house competitions were held.

July 2019

Inter-House Football Matches (Boys): The Inter-house football matches were held for Classes IX to XII from 1st to 5th July, 2019 and for Classes VI to VIII from 8th to 10th July, 2019.

Visit to the Departmental Store: Students of classes LKG and UKG were taken to a departmental store on 12th July, 2019. A group of 58 students were taken to Aapka Bazar, Sector-12, Dwarka.

Slogan writing, Painting and Poster making activity by DOE: The students of Classes III to VIII actively participated in slogan writing, painting and poster making activity on the theme 'Save our Earth'. Directorate of Education provided this great opportunity to the school students as a part of the Jan Shakti Abhiyan that was held on 15th July, 2019.

Tree Plantation Drive by DOE: NEPS always strives to make the New Erians sensitive and aware towards environment. With the noble mission of making our city green and serene, the students of Class X at NEPS, Dwarka organised a plantation drive on 15th July, 2019 as a part of Jan Shakti Abhiyan launched by Directorate of Education, Delhi. The motto behind this initiative was an effort to sensitize students towards poor air quality index. The students planted over a hundred saplings of indigenous trees in the school grounds to raise awareness and consciousness about environment among the school students. Students were given the responsibility of nurturing these saplings through the year.

Renaissance: The verve and excitement were evident and contagious as students from 19 schools participated in Renaissance 2019 at New Era Public School, Dwarka on 25th and 26th July 2019. The two day inter-school fest comprised of the most innovative competitions such as TED talks, Spill poetry, Milkshake with me, Alternate reality, Website Designing, Navras Bhaav Pradarshan , Entrepreneurs' meet etc. Persons accomplished in different fields – Arts, theatre, performing arts and computers were invited to judge the events. New Era Public School Dwarka and St. Thomas' School Dwarka tied for the Rolling Trophy, wherein the host school presented the coveted trophy to the latter.

All India Championship Series U-14 Tennis Tournament: New Era Public School Dwarka had the privilege to host the All India Championship Series U-14 Tennis Tournament at the school tennis courts from 22nd July, 2019 to 26th July, 2019. This tournament was played under the aegis of the AITA (ALL India Tennis Association). More than 150 students in both categories of boys and girls all over India participated in this championship. This championship was for the All India ranking of U-14 players.

Three students of NEPS, Dwarka participated in this championship:

- Atulya Atri was adjudged the overall winner in 'Boys U-14' category and his India rating now stands at 81.
- Lagan Budhiraja reached the quarters (Round of 08) and is now ranked at 300.
- Vishesh Singh reached the Pre-Quarter (Round of 16) and is now ranked at 293.

Making of Newton's Disc Activity: The students of classes LKG and UKG enjoyed the Newton disc making activity wherein the little ones coloured the Newton disc in seven colours of the rainbow. The Newton disc is a well-known physics experiment with a

rotating disc with segments in different colours appearing as white when it spins very fast. Children could also relate the Newton's disc to the rainbow.

August 2019

Janamashtmi Activity - Flute decoration: Janmashtmi, the birth of lord Krishna was celebrated at New Era Public School, Dwarka with great pomp and festivity by the tiny tots of Kindergarten.

On 22nd July 2019, flute decoration activity was held for classes LKG and UKG. On the occasion of Janamasthmi, children decorated flutes with mirrors, sequins and peacock feathers.

Water Conservation Workshop by NGO 'Swechha': A workshop was conducted by an NGO - Swechha at New Era Public School, Dwarka for the students of Class VI-VIII on 29th August 2019 on - "Water crisis and its conservation". Students were made aware about the importance of water and the factors leading to water crisis.

Inter-House Science Competitions: New Era Public School, Dwarka organized an inter house science competition for the classes VI-XII on 22.08.2019.

Different topics were allotted to different categories:

Students of class VI worked in teams to make a model on Water/air purifier.

Students of class VII were assigned the topic of hydraulics. Each team presented a model based on the same such as hydraulic lifts, hydraulic cranes and hydraulic bridge.

The teams from class VIII presented their research work on the topic 'A visit to a cell' through a PPT. The teams from classes IX to XII presented their working model on varied topics such as types of irrigation, sources of energy and its conservation. The models were supplemented with beautiful charts prepared by the teams.

Celebrating Rakshabandhan with the Prime Minister: On 15th August 2019, three students - Yashvi Vats, Vedika Raina and Bhumi Dabas- visited the Prime Minister's residence to celebrate Rakshabandhan with the honourable Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi and seek his blessings. The students were accompanied by the Director, Mr. Rohit Chopra and the Principal, Ms. Kanwal Kohli.

Independence 2019: The 73rd Independence Day was celebrated with much pomp and zeal at New Era Public School, Dwarka.

A day infused with energy was witnessed by all with the students from classes L.K.G. to XII presenting a special assembly on this day of national significance. The festivities began with hoisting of the National Flag by the Chairperson, Mrs. Usha Chopra, the Director Mr. Rohit Chopra, and the Principal, Mrs. Kanwal Kohli. As the National Flag was unfurled, the National Anthem was sung by all. This was followed by an array of performances, the first being a patriotic song by the Junior Choir. The melodious song filled the hearts of all with pride. After this, the students of classes XII and X shared their views about freedom being accompanied by responsibilities and the India they dream of, respectively. Ensuing these thoughts was another patriotic song, this time by the Senior Choir. Finally, the extravaganza came to a close with a spectacular dance performance by the middle school students and the Chairperson asking everyone to contribute towards a better India.

Fancy dress Activity: The children of Classes LKG and UKG participated in the Fancy Dress activity held on 14th August 2019. The theme was 'Freedom fighters'. The children came dressed in different costumes. Children looked beautiful dressed up as Bhagat Singh, Rani Lakshmi Bai, Sarojini Naidu and Begum Hazrat Mahal.

Tree Plantation Drive 'Green Earth, Clean Earth': Delhi State Legal Services Authority in coordination with Foundation & Rotary International undertook a project 'Green Earth, Clean Earth' to sensitize the students of New Era Public School, Dwarka about the environment. Ms. Aeshna Dahiya, the nominated Legal Aid Counsel interacted with the students to spread awareness about tree plantation. The students planted around 100 saplings in and around the school premises.

Visit to the Fire Station: As a part of their monthly 'out of school learning' programme, students of LKG and UKG visited the fire station at Sector 6. The Fire Station Master explained the services rendered by them. They were acquainted with the working of the fire truck. The students were also updated with the number to be dialed in case of an emergency.

September 2019

Tree Plantation Drive by NGO 'Sweccha': A tree plantation drive was conducted in school premises on 2nd September 2019 by the NGO - Sweccha. Students of class VIII participated with great enthusiasm. Students were introduced to the concept of urban forest. Students planted 50 indigenous trees with great zeal in the school ground and converted a barren land into an urban mini forest inspired by the Japanese technique of 'Miyawaki'. This technique helps to build dense native forests. The approach is supposed to ensure 10 times faster plant growth with a plantation that is 30 times denser than usual.

Teachers' Day: The student council had taken up the responsibility of the whole scintillating cultural show to denote their love, respect, acknowledgement and recognition of the hard work put in by the teachers towards their development. The cultural show incorporated poems, songs and dance. The programme began with the rendition of Gayatri Mantra by the choir followed by a beautiful poem recital by a student of class X. What set a euphoric atmosphere was the foot tapping dance number by the students of class XI. It left everyone swaying to the musical tune of the dance number. The students also presented creative self made cards with apt titles for the teachers.

Nukkad Naatak For 'Clean India': As a part of community outreach programme of the school and the SEWA Project, the students of class IX of New Era Public School, Dwarka exhibited their concern for a Clean India through a Nukkad Naatak (Street Play) in and around the vicinity of Pochanpur village in Dwarka.

On 4th of September these youngsters set out with zeal and enthusiasm and took upon themselves to spread awareness regarding cleanliness, importance of planting trees and as to how water can be conserved. They also gave tips on how kitchen waste should be segregated into green and blue dustbins.

Show and Tell Activity: Show and Tell Activity was conducted on 17.09.2019 for the students of LKG and UKG to strengthen the verbal skills and to foster public speaking competency of the young minds. The theme of the activity was "My favourite bird". The little ones were excited to share their descriptive narration and waited eagerly for their turn to show and tell. It was an enriching experience for the students to learn about different birds from their friends.

Visit to the Post Office: Students of classes LKG and UKG visited the post office in Sector 6. This visit gave them an opportunity to learn about one of the oldest means of communication and know the functioning of a post office.

Inter-house Science Quiz Competition: An inter-house science quiz competition was held on 24th September, 2019 for Classes I to V. There were 8 rounds, 4 rounds for Classes I-III and 4 rounds for Classes III-V. The questions asked were based on general science. All the participants and audience participated enthusiastically.

Counselling Session for Classes X to XII: Ashoka University organised a counselling session for the students of Classes X-XII on liberal education on 25th September 2019 at New Era Public School Dwarka. Mr. Vikram Bawa, Director (Outreach) from Ashoka University enlightened the students on various options available for the students for higher education and the admission process for the same.

CBSE Capacity Building Workshop – Life skills: A workshop on Capacity Building Programme on Life Skills was organised on 27th September, 2019 at New Era Public School, Dwarka for the teachers so that they can impart the same to students and enable them to confront the world.

This workshop was an initiative by CBSE and was conducted under the guidance of Mr. Pankaj Munjal, a resource person from CBSE. **Thirty one** participants from well-known CBSE schools took part in the day-long session to learn about various ways and techniques of developing and enhancing life skills among students across all age groups.

The workshop focused on developing skills like self-awareness, assertiveness, empathy, critical thinking, interpersonal skills, effective communication, coping with stress, decision making etc. In a nutshell life skills would ensure holistic development of a child.

The objective to be achieved, as per CBSE, by conducting this workshop, was to make teachers well equipped with knowledge that can help them manage and deal with innumerable (small or big) instances happening inside/outside the classrooms. The workshop not only made the teachers more sensitive and understanding towards students, but also helped in imbibing life skills in their teaching style so that children of today get education that adds value to their personality as a whole.

Trip to Shimla-Chail-Kufri: A trip to Shimla, Chail and Kufri was organised just after the mid-term examinations between 25th and 30th September for classes VI-XII.

October 2019

Special Assembly Dussehra and Gandhi Jayanti: A special assembly for Dussehra and Gandhi Jayanti was organised by students of classes VII and VIII.

Diya Decoration Activity: Diya Decoration Activity was conducted for Classes LKG and UKG on 22nd October 2019. Children brought diyas and decorative material for this activity. The diyas were beautifully decorated by the little ones.

Special Assembly Diwali: A special assembly for Diwali was conducted by the students of classes LKG, UKG and III - VIII.

December 2019

The event comprised of 12 teams from Delhi/NCR. This three day event saw some great talent from various schools.

The final of the tournament was played between Basava International School, Dwarka and Sri Venkateshwara International School Sector-18, Dwarka.

In a nail biting finish which went upto extra time, the latter triumphed with a 2-1 victory.
